### Delegates to the Australian Dragon Boat Federation.

1. Clause 5 of the Constitution of AusDBF lists the responsibilities of Member Organisations. DBSA is a Member Organisation of AusDBF.
2. Item 10.12 states that "Each Voting Member is entitled to appoint an individual as their voting member."
3. Under the Dragon Boat SA Constitution
  - **Objects and Purpose of the Association.**  
3. d... to liaise with interstate organisations to ensure South Australia's representation in Dragon Boating at the National and International level.
  - **The Committee Powers and Duties**  
6.1 (111). The Committee shall have the authority to interpret the meaning of these rules and any other matter relating to the affairs of the Association on which these rules are silent.
4. The DBSA Constitution is silent in regard to any Delegate to AusDBF.
5. DBSA has resolved that the Delegate to represent the Association at AusDBF level will be the President or in the President's absence the Vice President.
6. If there is a vacancy in one or more of the above positions at the time of an AusDBF meeting, the remaining Committee members shall appoint a replacement from the Committee.

### POLICY REVIEW
