



Subject Life Membership

1. Purpose

This Policy outlines the eligibility and requirements for nominating someone for Life Membership of the Association.

2. Eligibility for Life Membership

Persons are eligible for consideration for Life Membership if they have:

- (a) made a significant contribution to DragonBoat SA over a period of not less than ten years; or
- (b) made a significant contribution to the sport of dragon boating in South Australia over a period of not less than 10 years; and
- (c) served DragonBoat SA in a direct capacity (eg office bearer, delegate, employee, selector, coach, official or manager).

3. Nominations – Life Membership

- (a) Members may nominate eligible persons for Life Membership to the Board of DragonBoat SA.
- (b) The Board will make recommendations for Life Membership to a DragonBoat SA General Meeting.
- (c) Nominations for Board consideration must be received by the Secretary of DragonBoat SA 8 weeks prior to the DBSA General Meeting.

4. Election – Life Membership

- (a) The nominee shall be elected to the position of Life Membership by a simple majority of those present and eligible to vote at a General Meeting in accordance with Clause 8.5(i), 5.1(i) and 5.1(iii) of the DragonBoat SA Constitution.
- (b) Any person so elected shall become a Life Member of DragonBoat SA with effect at the close of the meeting.

5. Benefits

Life members are to pay their respective registration fee however will be exempt from any membership fee if introduced.

POLICY REVIEW

This Policy will be reviewed every two years to ensure that the document remains current, practical and relevant for DBSA. The next review date being November 2020.
