### **PREAMBLE:**

Dragon Boat SA is aware that there are occasions when a paddler registered with another Club interstate may be in Adelaide for a brief or ad hoc period and wish to train with an SA based Club. The following rule will apply:

- An Australian registered paddler who wishes to train with a SA Club is entitled to **four** free sessions; after which if it is going to be a longer-term arrangement, a fee of \$55 (GST inclusive) will be payable. The paddler would already be covered by the Parent Club for insurance and the AusDBF levy would have been paid by the Parent Club.

The paddler will not be registered in the DBSA online database as “a SA paddler”.
