6.2 01/12/13 - 10s & 20s over 500m + 2km race - wrap up

- Suggestion from Subsonix that the two outside lane Sweeps toggles be removed prior to commencement of the 1&2 km events as there is potential for paddles to get caught.
 - Agreed this was a beneficial idea and should be included on the task list for the event by the organising Club and advised to the Rescue Boat driver to remove prior.
- In relation to the previous event whereby a race jury was formed to hear an appeal about an alleged incident during the 2km race with one team not finishing within the buoys John Holland noted that it should not have been handled in this manner. The proper way was for the Chief Umpire to be informed of the alleged incident and for any penalty to be applied and if appealed by the Club then a race jury should be formed to hear the appeal.
 - Clubs were advised that they could also inform the Chief Official of any alleged incidents.
- ♣ Discussion was then held on the correct passing rules whilst turning a buoy in relation to the inside boat having right of way and the outside boat without 'clear water' needing to avoid the inside boat to avoid being penalised.
