6 GENERAL BUSINESS

6.1 25/9/16 – 20s over 200m – wrap up

- Noted Wendy Campbell (Subsonix) had offered to send the race results through after each event as she was working in the Judge's tent however the Club assigned to this task would still have to check this on each occasion.
- Noted there were some inconsistencies with the racing on the day. Firstly some teams took it upon themselves to not back into the bridge with others doing this as requested as the 'small boats' event was cancelled. Secondly the boats did not all start in the lanes assigned as on occasion they were advised by the Chief Official to move down to Lane 1. This created some uncertainty. Agreed that the race draw has to be followed for lane allocation for many reasons with one being that it helps organising Clubs when looking back to check lane allocations.
- The question was asked if the lanes were exactly the same length and how it was certain that this was the case. The response given was that the confidence was in the Council's measurements.

6.2 16/10/16 – 20s over 500m – planning

Arrangements were noted as follows:
