



## **POLICY: INTERSTATE PADDLING VISITOR**

### **Introduction**

DragonBoat SA is aware that there are occasions when a paddler registered with an interstate Club may be in Adelaide for a brief or ad hoc period and wish to train with a SA based Club.

### **Purpose**

The purpose of this policy is to set out the guidelines for interstate paddling visitors.

### **Policy**

An Australian registered paddler who wishes to train with a SA Club is entitled to four free sessions; after which if it is going to be a longer-term arrangement, a fee of \$55 (GST inclusive) will be payable. The paddler would already be covered by the Parent Club for insurance and the AusDBF levy would have been paid by the Parent Club.
