5.1 Sat 22-Oct – Peter Bristow Long Course – feedback

- Lyn Payne BSD – questioned if Peter Bristow can be changed back to an open event to enable more Clubs to participate in their own right especially if they have more women than men and whether Race Committee can initiate? Confirmed it would be race committee. Chris Wood noted all male crews create an unfair advantage and agreement from committee to remain as stands.
- Lyn Payne suggested composite crews be organised ahead of the meeting to ensure an efficient meeting – suggested this be added to pre-race task list for Powerblades with an email to all clubs on composite crews and methodology for raising crew needs and matching to support maximising crews.
- ASA / Mannum / Copper Coast – sweep was overridden by people in the boat – suggested clarification at briefing and by clubs.
- Powerblades asked for confirmation timing of starts worked for all.
- ACDC Chris Wood suggested a 4 min gap between composite and sports crews for fairness. Pat confirmed and explained the rules.
- Copper Coast / Mannum sweep – it was noted the radio was not on; committee confirmed radios had been checked and were backed up with a mobile phone in each boat as reception can be poor on the other side of the island. Chris noted her radio was silent but on – Pat noted he checked in with the safety boat every 15 minutes.

5.1.1 Chief Official's report

Event started on time, Sweeps and Captains meeting went well, covered rules regulations, radios working safety procedures followed. Race started at 6pm sharp with 2 min gaps and boats finished 4 mins apart. Maria Darby and Joy Fisher did the timekeeping. No incidents and all crews smiling on return.

5.1.3 Task List – any changes?

Confirmed timing tablet working well and taking to Wallaroo. Steve listed for timing on task list – confirmed he will get instruction on use.

5.2 Sat 19-Nov – Wallaroo Marina Challenge – planning

- Noted Powerblades had not input any races – apologies from Sharon Etherington for not inputting by deadline. Confirmed Powerblades will enter all categories. Only 2 crews for Senior C open and need 3 to run. Powerblades will enter two crews to ensure the category can run.
- Powerblades taking 4 boats (2 trailers) up Friday evening with set up Saturday morning at 7:30am at the boat ramp. Clubs to provide some bodies to help unload and paddle boats around to the marina. At end of regatta crews in last race/s to paddle boats back to ramp and assist loading onto trailers
- Heads, tails, drums, sweep oars and ropes all required for the 4 boats being transported.
- Copper Coast confirmed the pontoon is locked for boat security – need access for unloading.
- Task list discussed and will be updated and distributed by Copper Coast; Starter's umbrella (if needed) / boat at pontoon with toilet & radio, start & finish lines deployed by John Gore's boat. Pat & Neil to assist / show others (need more people to understand how to do).
- No FinishLynx system – using tablet for timings.
- Ale House – noted clubs need to make their own bookings if choosing to dine there.
